hen Jeff, a student at the Hong Kong Junior School set up by the Autism Children Foundation, looked up into my eyes and thanked me for visiting his school, he also handed me a copy of the poem above.

After reading it and watching the students and their dedicated teachers working together, I gained not only a better understanding of autism, but also of the many possibilities available to the autistic child—if only he is given the chance to pursue them.

ACF began as a group of parents of autistic children seeking affordable specialised learning programmes tailored to their children's particular needs. In November 2008, after three years of extensively researching the most effective teaching methods, training highly qualified teachers, and joining with professionals in the academic and medical fields who had long experience in working with autistic children. ACF opened the first school in Hong Kong dedicated solely to teaching children with autism.

A student's typical day includes a morning spent learning the usual school subjects from language to maths and computers, with the

afternoon dedicated to social activities and occupational therapy exercises. ACF offers a wide range of proven educational therapies and shares information about biomedical treatments, putting an emphasis on combining those approaches that work best for each individual child. Each student's academic progress is carefully tracked, and ACF hopes to launch in full the Brain Bio Kids' Programme, which provides regular testing, diagnosis and treatment

The prevalence of autism around the world has reached epidemic proportions over the past 20 years, but because it is not considered a life-threatening condition, it often does not receive the funding and attention it deserves. # 自閉症兒童基金協會

天參觀自閉症兒童基金協會創辦的Hong Kong Junior School時,其中一名學生Jeff抬頭望著我,感謝我到訪,並遞給我上述的詩句。

皆因我不能像你般表達自己,也未能説出自己的需要......

這首詩讓我更了解自閉症兒童的心聲,而實地探訪,也讓我看見 老師不遺餘力地獻身教育,學生積極配合努力學習。這不但令我對 自閉症有了更多認識,同時使我明白到,只要給予自閉症兒童更多 機會,或許能他們能發掘出更多可能性。

自閉症兒童基金協會(ACF)是由一群熱心父母發起的組織,他們的子女同樣患有自閉症。在成立初期,ACF四出物色專門課程,以配合自閉症孩子的特殊需要,同時也要確保學費維持於可負擔範 園內。在過去三年,ACF廣泛研究各種最具成效的教學方法,積極 培訓高質素的導師,並與相關的學術及醫療專家合作,這些專家統 統在自閉兒童方面具豐富經驗。最終,ACF在2008年11月至香港成立 了第一所專為自閉症兒童而設的學校。

學生平日的活動可分上下午兩部分,上午會學習語文、數學和電 服等一般學科知識,下午則主要上社交活動課和進行職業治療練習。 ACF亦為學童提供各種療法,例如一些經證實有效的教育治療,也會 提供生物醫學療法方面的資訊,並結合有關療法,應用於學童身上。 務求令每名學童都能獲得最有效的治療。此外,校方亦會人心檢視每 名學童的學業進度,期望全力推行Brian Bio Kids 計劃,當中包括安 排合資格醫療人員為學童定期進行測試,診斷和治療。

過去20年,全球的自閉症病例日趨普遍,不過,自閉症不被視為 危及性命的病症,所以往往得不到應有的資助和關注。若能集績成 裘,得到你的捐助和支持,將有助ACF填補香港在這方面的空日。■
